



OASIS III FLOAT PLAN



*The Skipper must complete sections 3-7 and submit it to the Commodore for approval at least 15 days prior to departure.
He must also complete sections 9 & 10 on the morning of departure.*

OASIS III must carry no less than three nor more than six persons, two of whom must be qualified Skippers. The total trip may not exceed four consecutive days.

A copy of this report will be left with the Commodore (or the next officer in line) who will notify the U. S. COAST GUARD or another rescue organization in case OASIS III does not return as scheduled. If the return is delayed, the Skipper must inform the Commodore (or the officer holding the float plan) in order that an unnecessary search will be avoided.
